

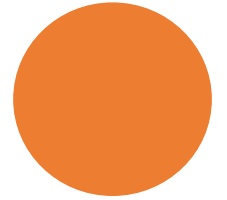
But a safe delivery for mother and child is a journey that begins well before conception.

Consanguineous marriage is still high in Egypt (35.3%), especially among first cousins (86%).


